Nature of work performed:

Underwent more than six years of intensive surgical and medical training at All India Institute of Medical Sciences, with vast exposure in trauma and cold (conventional) Orthopaedics. Regular posting in ward, out patient department, O.T. and casualty provided extensive opportunities to diagnose and plan treatment for various orthopaedic ailments. Good first hand surgical training and experience of procedures in nearly all of trauma cases (fresh and old-neglected) and arthroplasty has been ample. My first hand works in the field of bone tumors and custom made prostheses in lieu of my thesis has put me forward in the treatment of this dreadful disorder. *Specialized* experience in management of spine disorders, Pediatric Orthopaedics, Ilizarov method of management, arthroscopy (knee, shoulder, ankle, and elbow) has helped build confidence.

Working as senior resident, under various specialists like hand surgeon, arthroscopist, tumor surgeon, arthroplasty and spine surgeons on a regular basis dwelled into finely polishing the various faculties within and preparing for all branches in orthopaedics. I have been independently practiced & executed the learned skills as **Assistant professor** of Orthopaedics at Lady Hardinge Medical College and associated hospitals. I worked as senior consultant arthroplasty and arthroscopy surgeon at TATA motors hospital, Jamshedpur; exclusively performing arthroplasty (hip, knee, shoulder, elbow, MCP etc) and knee, shoulder & wrist arthroscopy. Now I am working as senior

consultant and chief of Orthopedics performing arthroplasty, arthroscopy, spine surgery apart from routine trauma, pediatric orthopedics and deformity correction at shri Mata Vaishno Devi Narayana superspecialty hospital, Katra.

I have experience of independently performing more than **500 knee replacements, 350 total hip replacements, 400 hemi-arthroplasties (hip), 20 shoulder hemiarthroplasties, 15 elbow replacements, >150 arthroscopic ACL reconstructions, 10 PCL reconstructions, and 10 multiligament injury of knee and elbow, 15 wrist arthroscopies (7 TFCC reconstructions/repair), 90 megaprosthesis implantations for bone tumors, 79 other limb reconstructions (bone tumors), ~150-160 complex trauma reconstructions, 17 DDH surgeries, >40 CTEV surgeries, >50 ilizarov limb reconstructions apart from routine trauma cases that are a part of general orthopedic practice.** The independent surgical experience has been preceded by around double the number of assisted/supervised surgeries as the parent institute AIIMS has a tremendous patient inflow and work load.

As senior research associate (Pool Scheme) the preceding was extended into specialized hand training and research during under Prof. P. P. Kotwal. I have performed 3 MCP arthroplasties, 4 Elbow arthroplasties, 2 Total shoulder arthroplasties, 4 shoulder hemiarthroplasties, >10 rheumatoid hand reconstructions, >15 tendon grafting, >10 tendon transfers, >10 radial longitudinal deficiency reconstructions, >25 nerve repairs, >15 different soft tissue coverage surgeries independently.

As Senior consultant in Orthopedics at Tata Motors hospital all joint arthroplasties and trauma work was done as an independent authority with well recognition in the faculty in the region. This recognition led me to become the head of department and incharge Orthopedics at Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Narayana Superspecialty hospital at Kakrayal, Katra. Here I have established the department of Orthopedics with all state of the art facilities and procedures. We have begun the niche work like shoulder arthroscopy, arthroplasties and orthopedic oncology.

Lots of active work related to research and perpetuation of knowledge has been undertaken by me simultaneously; that is represented in the internationally renowned publications as depicted in annexure 2. Participation into various orthopaedic and related activities to continuously update my knowledge and keep an edge forward by learning new techniques has been met through attending various conferences and meetings.
